## (2)Introduction

When I say such things, some people feel frightened and think, "What if I become possessed?" They also say, "I will be scared if it is an evil spirit, but if it is a guardian spirit I will welcome it." There must be so many dead people with varieties of feelings just like we are all different. Some must be holding a grudge against someone, feeling grateful to someone, feeling grief over their death or feeling hopeful about setting off for an unknown world. Also, although people temporarily forget it, there is certainly warmth deep inside anyone's heart; the same applies to the dead.

When negative responses eventually turn into positive after receiving ki, it means that Shinkiko energy has reached to your soul and refreshed your mind.

Spirits are in various states of mind. When they get the energy, their feelings come to the fore and seem to appear beneath our awareness. So, sometimes, negative-minded spirits temporarily make people to experience strong negative reactions, but they eventually turn into positive.

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
